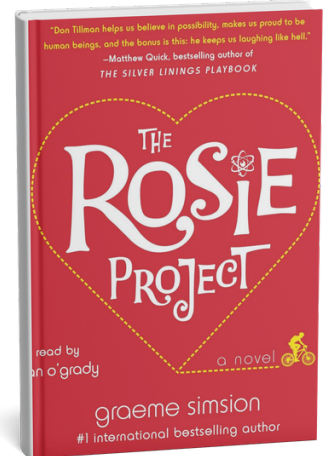

A charming and humorous novel about growth, communication, and learning to understand others with empathy. Encourages emotional intelligence and relationship leadership.



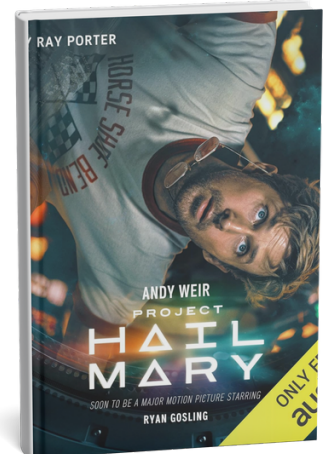

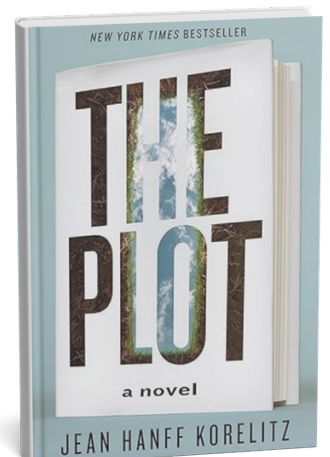

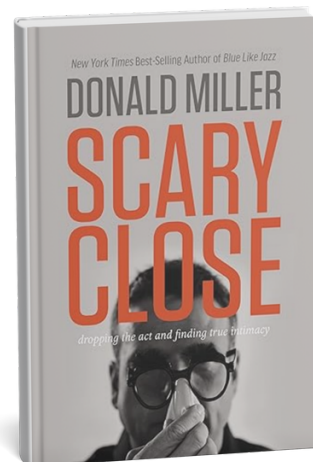
NON-FICTION

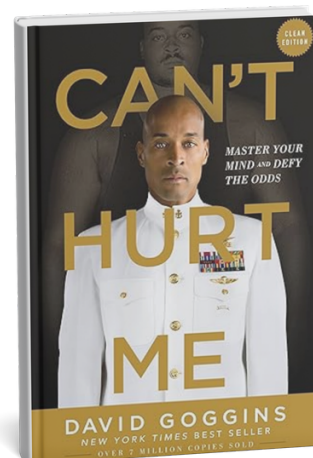
NON-FICTION

by Viktor Frankl - 1946
