A practical workbook-style guide that provides activities and strategies for developing emotional regulation, positive social skills, and the foundational aspects of leading by example (Law of Influence).



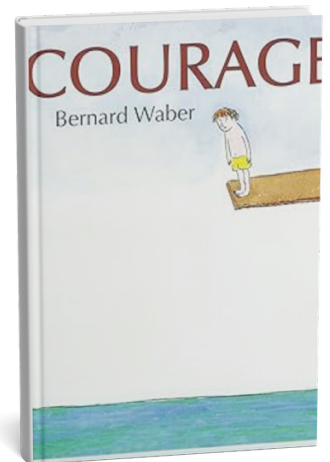
